## **General Position Summary:**

- 6. Implement Media Campaigns
- 7. Update the Supervisor of any problems associated with a program session including staff issues, low program attendance, tardiness, etc. within 24 hours of the session.
- 8. Utilize database to record program attendance and demographics.
- 9. Assist with the development of documents and reports.
- 10. Organize and provide presentations to community agencies, schools, or businesses on prevention issues.
- 11. Provide health information at local parades and health fairs.
- 12. Uphold the overall mission and goals of Prevention Partnership, Inc.
- 13. Provide other support consistent with job roles assigned.
